What is a SNOW EMERGENCY?

A Snow Emergency may be called by the Mayor, based on the recommendation of the Police Department and the Street Department. The levels of emergency are listed below for your reference:

Level 1: Roadways are hazardous with blowing and drifting snow. Roads are also icy. Drive cautiously.

Level 2: Roadways are hazardous with blowing and drifting snow. Only those who feel it is necessary to drive should be out on the roadways. Contact your employer to see if you should report to work.

Level 3: All roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel. No one should be out during these conditions unless it is absolutely necessary to travel. All employees should contact their employers to see if they should report to work. Those traveling on roadways may subject themselves to arrest.

The Police Department may post “No Parking” signs in the downtown district to facilitate the removal of snow from the parking spaces in front of the businesses by the Village Street Department.

Please do not push snow from your driveway into the street as it creates a safety hazard for other drivers. Please push the snow into the right-of-way or yard.

Snow Emergencies are reported to local radio stations including 96.1FM and also the local TV stations (13abc). Any snow emergency will be listed online at www.villageoffayette.com in the announcement section on the right side.
